Section 13006 of 21st Century Cures Act from the Anna Westin Act

Eligibility

- Domestic public and private non-profit entities



Dates

- Deadline: Aug. 17, 2018
- Start date: Sept. 30, 2018
- Project Length: Up to 5 years



Funding

- \$750,000 available in funding
- One (1) award
- No cost sharing/match requirements



Required Activities

- Facilitate in identifying model programs and materials for training health professionals on eating disorders
 - Identify individuals with eating disorders
 - Provide early intervention services for individuals with eating disorders
 - Refer patients with eating disorders for appropriate treatment
 - Prevent the development of eating disorders
 - Provide appropriate treatment services for individuals with eating disorders
 - Provide integrated care that addresses eating disorders, other mental and substance use disorders, and physical health disorders that may co-occur in individuals living with eating disorders
 - Provide training on implementation of programs to address eating disorders and co-occurring conditions
- Provide up-to-date resources and information on the prevention and treatment of eating disorders

- Provide publicly available on-demand virtual training and up-to-date information on the prevention and treatment of eating disorders

Allowable Activities

- Provide tailored training and TA opportunities related to eating disorder prevention and treatment for specific populations
